NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: CYC extends an invitation to all interested skippers and crew to participate in a “for fun” race series on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges. CYC will be sanctioning this event for the 2012 portion of the year.

DESCRIPTION & BACKGROUND: “Sailing on Sundays” has been an informal race between skippers throughout the years to hone skills for the Oregon Offshore and summer time series racing. “Sailing on Sundays” or the “ISR series” has been run by Terry Johnson “Snidely Marks” the last two years. Snidely’s imagination and his dedication to sailing combined with his talent for writing, created a winter time racing culture filled with great racing and satirical humor. This event has attracted a variety of racers and cruisers who all share in a desire for sailing and light hearted competition.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: Entrants must comply with the insurance provisions of the OCSA Race Entry Form. PHRF ratings are not required, but if you do have a current or past PHRF rating, please include on your entry form. If you do not have a PHRF rating one will be assigned to you based on boat of similar design. Any unregistered boat is ineligible to race.

DATES AND TIMES: Sundays 1/08/12 thru 3/04/12. The first start will be 1300 hours each Sunday. Starts and classes to be determined each week by the designated Race Committee. The start line will be between buoy 14 and the east most corner of Rose City Yacht Club docks. Finish line will be the same. Racing will resume in the fall 10/14/2012 thru 11/18/2012. We will break for Thanksgiving weekend; we will then resume racing 12/02/2012 & 12/09/2012 then break for Christmas. Check the 2013 Racebook for 2013 series dates.

REGISTRATION AND FEES: Registration is free, but all skippers must register for this event. Use an OCSA Race Entry Form and scan and email to isr.committee@gmail.com, this is for insurance reasons.

THERE IS NO ENTRY FEE, BUT ALL BOATS REGISTERED ARE EXPECTED TO VOLUNTEER AS RACE COMMITTEE ONE SUNDAY IN THE SERIES, THE COMMITTEE BOAT WILL RECEIVE FIRST PLACE FOR THE DAY THEY VOLUNTEER.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions and breaks will be determined according to PHRF ratings. If you do not have a PHRF rating one will be assigned to you based on boat of similar design.

COURSES: The course each week shall be a combination of the permanent navigational aids 14, 18 and 2, course to be determined by designated Race Committee for that week. Race committee will be on VHF channel 72; races will be started with VHF countdown and a horn blast for each class start. Classes and start times will be predetermined and emailed in a “Hype” email each week preceding the race.

SCORING: The scoring will be decided by the designated Race Committee each week, which will be either level fleet scoring or PHRF. Race committee will receive a first place tie with the first place position of the day in their corresponding fleet. Results will be posted on www.sailpdx.com.

PROTESTS: There will be no protests heard, the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing shall be followed and disputes shall be handled among parties with Corinthian spirit.
