NOTICE OF RACE

OWSA is organizing the race and CYC will provide race management

INVITATION: The Oregon Women's Sailing Association and Corinthian Yacht Club invite all women sailors to the OWSA & CYC Women's Race to be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: Competitive women sailors pit their racing skills against one another in this one day regatta with up to three races scheduled. We would love to have several level fleets in attendance. A spectator boat will be available for significant others.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: All entrants and crew must be women. Skippers must be members of a PIYA recognized club, OCSA, or OWSA. The current International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing with the prescriptions of US Sailing, current OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and any supplemental sailing instructions will govern these races. Any unregistered boat is ineligible to race.

DATES AND TIME: August 7, first warning signal is at 1400 hours. When more than one race is scheduled to be held on the same day, racers should remain in the vicinity of the Race Committee after all boats in their class have finished, to receive additional signals from Race Committee.

FEES: \$30 for members of a PIYA recognized yacht club or OWSA, \$35 for all others. Skipper MUST notify the OWSA Race Captain of her intention to enter the race by 72 hours prior to the start of the race. Please make check payable to OWSA.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions will be posted on the committee boat or provided in a handout. The Race Committee may also provide additional supplemental instructions.

COURSES: Courses from the 2010 OCSA Course Charts or courses set by the Race Committee will be posted on the committee boat.

SCORING: One race shall constitute a series. Boats withdrawing from a race MUST notify the Race Committee to avoid disqualification.

TROPHIES: Awards will be presented at the OWSA general meeting in October.

PROTESTS: Protests are not encouraged. Protesting boats must pass the Race Committee upon finishing to report her protest and receive instructions. Protests will be held at a time and place announced by the Race Committee.

COMMUNICATIONS: Pass by the committee boat to receive additional supplemental sailing instructions. Results will be posted at www.sailpdx.com.
