NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: The Portland Yacht Club cordially invites all eligible boats to participate in the Portland Yacht Club Centennial Regatta, to be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: This event is a three-day regatta with one evening race on Friday. At least two races will be attempted on Saturday and Sunday.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: All skippers must be members in good standing of a PIYA recognized yacht club. All boats must have a current PHRF rating unless sailing one design or level fleet. If a boat is not listed in the current PHRF roster, submit a photocopy of the rating certificate with your entry form. Races shall be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing including the national prescriptions of US Sailing, as modified by the OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and the supplemental instructions of this notice.

DATES AND TIMES:

Friday, June 6

The warning signal for the race will be at 1830 hours

Saturday, June 7 and Sunday, June 8

The warning signal for the first race will be 1400 hours

When more than one race is scheduled on the same day, racers should remain in the vicinity of the Race Committee, after all boats in their class have finished, to receive additional signals from the Race Committee. A start sequence for the finished fleet may begin shortly after the last boat finishes.
