

RCYC Summer Regatta June 19 & 20

NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: Rose City Yacht Club invites all eligible boats to participate in the RCYC Summer Regatta to be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: This is a two-day regatta consisting of two or more races on each day.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: All skippers must be members of a PIYA recognized yacht club. Races shall be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the national prescriptions of US Sailing, except as modified by the OCSA Sailing Instructions, the rules of any one design, level or PHRF fleet participating in the event, the notice of race for the event, or by the supplemental sailing instructions for the event. Club PHRF ratings may be assigned for boats racing in a PHRF or No-Fly-Sail fleet who are not members of PHRF-NW; ratings are issued by the club and are valid only for the event which they are issued.

DATES AND TIMES: Racing will be on June 19 & 20 and the scheduled warning signal for the first start will be at 1830 on Friday and 1200 on Saturday. Additional races will begin shortly after all boats in an individual class have finished. The starting sequence for finished fleets may begin in any order.

Skippers may also register via email by providing all information required on the OCSA Entry Form to: RCYC.RaceCapt@comcast.net Registrations received after 2000 hours on the Wednesday preceding the event will be subject to a \$10 late fee. No one-the-water registrations will be accepted.

FEE: \$30 for all competitors that are not members of RCYC. Make check payable to RCYC.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions will be provided to competitors by the Race Committee.

COURSES: Courses from the 2009 OCSA Course Charts or courses set by the Race Committee will be posted on the committee boat.

SCORING: All races will be scored using PHRF unless racing level or one design. There will be no makeup races. One completed race shall constitute a series. Boats withdrawing from a race shall notify the Race Committee on the water, if possible.

TROPHIES: The number of trophies per fleet will be determined by the number of boats entered by the registration deadline. Awards will be presented after the last race on Saturday at the RCYC Clubhouse.

PROTESTS: Any competitor choosing to file a protest shall notify the RC by hail or on VHF channel 72 immediately after finishing and before leaving the racing area. Protest forms shall be delivered to the Race Captain at the RCYC Clubhouse within 2 hours of the last finishing boat of the day.

COMMUNICATIONS: Additional Sailing Instructions may be provided by the Race Committee via email as well as posted on the RCYC web site at <http://www.rosecityyachtclub.org> prior to the event, or on-the-water; all competitors are strongly encouraged to provide a current email on their registration and to check the RCYC web site prior to the event. The Race Committee will monitor VHF channel 72 when possible and will only answer hails from boats reporting an emergency, retiring from a race or notifying the Race Committee of a protest. Race results will be posted at sailpdx.com and on the RCYC bulletin board on the moorage ramp.
