NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: The Corinthian Yacht Club invites all eligible boats to participate in the CYC Summer Evening Series, to be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: A 6 week evening series with one or more races scheduled each day. There will be one throw out race.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: Each entering skipper must be a member of a PIYA recognized yacht club or a member of OCSA. Each entering boat must have a current PHRF certificate unless sailing level or one design. All boats without a current PHRF certificate will not be scored. The current International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing with the prescriptions of US Sailing, current OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and any supplemental sailing instructions will govern these races. Any unregistered boat is ineligible to race.

DATES AND TIMES: The warning signal is at 1830 hours for all races.

Tuesday: All boats racing PHRF, and the 172 Fleet

July 21, 28 August 4, 11, 18 & 25

Thursday: Boats racing one design: Cal 20, J24, Ranger 20, & the cruising fleet

July 23, 30. August 6, 13, 20, & 27

FEES: \$30 for members of a PIYA recognized yacht club, \$40 for all others. Skippers must notify the CYC Race Captain of their intention to enter the race by 72 hours prior to the race. CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions will be posted on the committee boat or provided in handout.

COURSES: Courses from the 2009 OCSA Course Charts or courses set by the Race Committee will be posted on the committee boat. The committee boat may have a separate start and finish line.

SCORING: Six races are scheduled per series. There will be one throw out race.

TROPHIES: The awards presentation will be on Sunday October 4th after the CYC Fall Regatta. The number of prizes awarded will be based on the number of boats registered within the time limit.
