



HOSTED BY VANCOUVER LAKE SAILING CLUB

INVITATION: This seminar is sponsored by the US Sailing Race Management Committee and hosted by the Vancouver Lake Sailing Club. It is designed for people who have some Race Committee experience, but newcomers are also welcome.

DESCRIPTION: The topics covered include: RC objectives, RC responsibilities, sailing instructions, RC jobs, RC equipment, setting the course, starting system, starting penalties, before the start, during the race, finishing, and scoring. The changes in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 that affect race management will be discussed.

LOCATION: The seminar will be held at: Vancouver Lake Sailing Club, 7110 NW 25th Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98665

DATE: Saturday, February 4, 2012

TIME: The all day seminar begins at 0800 and ends at 1730

FOOD: Continental breakfast and lunch are included with your fee.

FEE: The seminar fee is \$45 for US Sailing members and \$90 for non-members. This fee includes breakfast, morning and afternoon breaks, lunch and all seminar materials.

INSTRUCTORS: The principal instructor for the seminar is Bill Gage. Bill is a US Sailing National Race Officer and the Area Race Officer for Area G. Assisting Bill will be Philip Parshley, who will helping with the teaching.

BRING: At the seminar you will need your own copy of "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012" ("RRS"). If you are a US Sailing member, you should have received a copy. Additional copies of the racing rules may be purchased from the US Sailing online store. You will be given a copy of "Join the Race Committee Team" at the seminar.

CERTIFICATION: The Club Race Officer certification test, which is given at the conclusion of the seminar, is optional. However, in order to be certified as a US Sailing Club Race Officer, you are required to attend a seminar and to pass the test. In order to be certified as a Club Race Officer you will also need to own a copy of the current "US Sailing Race Management Handbook", and also meet the program's other criteria. The 2009 edition of the Race Management Handbook is available from the US Sailing online store.
